I/we understand that St Heliers School will:

- Visit the home of the designated caregiver prior to enrolment (or as soon as possible), to determine that the living conditions are of an acceptable standard
- Assess whether the designated caregiver will provide a safe physical and emotional environment for the student
- Determine that the accommodation is not a boarding establishment (i.e. does not have 5 or more international students staying in the home)
- Meet with the designated caregiver/s and establish communication with the caregiver, visiting the home at least twice in a year.
- Meet the student at least quarterly to ensure the accommodation is suitable
- Require a Police vet to be undertaken.

Should this arrangement change I/we undertake to inform St Heliers School immediately.

I/we understand that *St Heliers School* will make every endeavour to ensure the safety and welfare of my/our child while studying in their school.

Should there be a concern about the welfare of the student, the school will consult the pastoral care staff within the school and will discuss the concern with the designated caregivers and when necessary, the parents of the student. Further, I/we understand that should *St Heliers School* have any concerns regarding the welfare of my/our child, the school may relocate the student in an approved School Homestay. If necessary, the school will also refer the matter to the relevant welfare authorities or any other appropriate outside agencies.
