### PTA Financial Summary 2019

It was a very busy year with fundraising events. The largest being our bi-annual School Fair.

Here is a short summary of some of the bigger events the PTA raised money in 2019:

- School Fair \$61,000
- Trivia Night \$18,000
- Art Calendars \$4,000
- Christmas Market \$3,000

In the next year, the PTA will continue to support school projects. The major items the donations are anticipated to help fund:

- \$45,000 to help fund the artificial turf in the Junior playground
- \$18,000 as part of on-going contribution towards the school's computer leases
- an estimated \$10,000 to help fund an outdoor/wet weather area for Rooms 4-6.

Thank you all once again for your support as the PTA could not make these contributions without your generosity and volunteer work.
